Dear Resident:

The Indiana County Solid Waste Authority will resume the curbside collection of glass bottles and jars, and food and beverage cans on July 1, 2020. We appreciate your patience during the reduced service period that began on April 13 due to concerns regarding the potential spread of COVID-19.

The Solid Waste Authority will continue its efforts to protect the health of recycling workers, you, your neighbors and our community. Please do not place potentially contaminated items out for curbside recycling collection if you or someone in your household has been sick, has tested positive for COVID-19, or is quarantined due to suspected exposure. Under these conditions, potentially contaminated recyclable items should be disposed of in a sealed bag with your trash.

As in the past, your blue recycling bin should be used for #1 & #2 plastic bottles only, while your smaller bin (green bin in Indiana Borough, maroon bin in White Township) should be used for glass bottles and jars, food and beverage cans, and bagged or tied newspapers. Please be sure to rinse containers to remove residues.

Again, thank you for your patience over the last couple months. We appreciate your participation in the curbside recycling program and remind you that drop-off containers for your residential materials are always available at the Indiana County Recycling Center in Homer City.
