

# White Township Official Map

## About the Official Map

This map is a representation of the White Township Official Map adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 1041 adopted January 26, 2011. A copy of the Official Map and Ordinance may be viewed at the White Township Office. Proposed roads represent ideal alignments. Variation from these alignments will be permitted and determined at time of application for a subdivision/land development plan approval. Pursuant to Section 404 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, The adoption of any street, street lines or other public lands pursuant to this article as part of the official map shall not, in and of itself, constitute or be deemed to constitute the opening or establishment of any street nor the taking or acceptance of any land, nor shall it obligate the municipality to improve or maintain any such street or land.

Rights-of-way shall be in conformance with the White Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and as directed by White Township.



Existing Public Roads: The Township and state roads detailed on this official map include the legal right of ways and such right of ways are not specifically delineated on the map. Rights-of-way vary from one location to another and are defined by state law, specific construction drawings, and/or documents of acquisition. The use of land within a right of way is restricted to prohibit encroachments on the use of the road and to preserve the right of way area for necessary improvements.

Road and Intersection Improvements: Proposed new roads/rights-of-way are intended to maintain and improve the level of service of the Township's roadway network. They are included on the Official Map to ensure the Township's ability to reserve the identified areas from private improvements and may be acquired for a public improvement. Any property which is crossed by a proposed improvement is subject to the reservations established by this Official Map and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

  - 2A-Connection to existing light at Oakland Avenue
  - 2B-Connection to proposed road 4
  - 2C-Connection to existing light at Plaza Road
- Proposed Road 3-Road to service White Farm
- Proposed Road 4-Oakland Avenue / Indian Springs / Rustic Lodge Connector
- Proposed Road 5-Fenton Road / Windy Ridge Connector
- Proposed Road 6-Windy Ridge Road / Rustic Lodge Connector
- Proposed Road 7-Second access for State Police, Novosel Center
